BEST Kids is a nonprofit mentoring organization that empowers youth in foster care to build better futures, one child at a time.





BEST Kids is guided by the belief that all children are talented. Through our one-on-one volunteer mentoring, extensive training, staff support, and experiential learning-based Peer Groups, we encourage our youth to discover and develop their unique skills and abilities. Beginning with children as young as six and continuing, as needed, until adulthood, BEST Kids works to enable youth to develop a positive sense of self and acquire teamwork skills. We believe that the way to achieve these goals is to have a stable, caring adult support them along this journey. We believe that **no** child should get “lost in the system” when there are empathetic role models right here in DC who have the wisdom and compassion to inspire them to achieve their potential.

There is a Better Way, and it Begins With You

BEST Kids matches each individual youth with one mentor – that’s you! Our one-on-one model provides mentees with undivided attention, intentional conversations, and sustainable support. As with any meaningful relationship, mentors are in it for the long haul. It is a level of stability urgently needed by these children. At BEST Kids, mentors are asked to mentor for at least one year; however, the relationships typically last far longer than that, and the value of the relationship lasts a lifetime.

Unlike a coach or teacher, mentors aren't assigned to one area of a youth's life – mentors can be present in every decision, life event, and experience their mentee goes through. Whether it's applying to college, dealing with peer pressure, or learning a new hobby, mentors can guide a young person through the many challenges and opportunities they will face. You are not randomly assigned. We have a structured matching process in which our mentors and mentees are paired based on their personalities, locations, schedules, and interests. You'll spend time with your mentee sharing in activities that you both enjoy. That could range from hiking along the Potomac, to bowling, visiting our city's world class museums, experiencing a cultural festival, or even better – finding something totally unconventional and uniquely enjoyed by both of you. Your engagement can help determine if a foster child becomes a success or statistic.

Facts of BEST Kids Mentee Outcomes

Every aspect of our programming is designed to reach positive outcomes for the children and youth we serve. Of the youth we surveyed:

88.24% said they can learn new things in school

88.24% said their caregiver understands them

76.47% said they think they are doing as well as other kids their age

80.39% said they always work hard to complete their schoolwork

Through one-on-one mentoring relationships with caring adults, mentees at BEST Kids consistently show:

- Increased academic achievement
- Improvement in social and/or emotional wellness
- Increased set of independent living skills
- Avoidance of risky behaviors

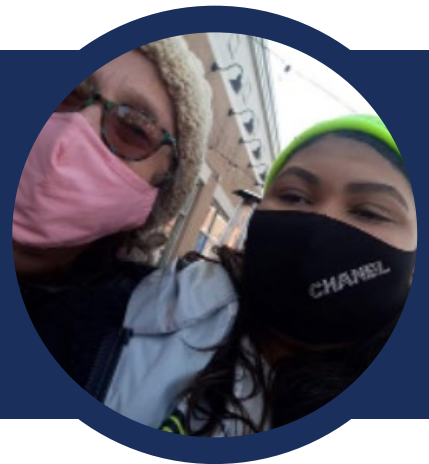


Bring an Open Heart, and We'll Take Care of the Rest
